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

ENROLLMENTS BY INSTITUTION




■ Nursing Facilities (69%)

Children's Hospitals

- Children's Hospitals are qualified institutions
- Applicants include:
 - » Premature infants in the NICU
 - » Children recovering from accidents or injury
 - » Children in parent or county custody
 - » Multiple Birth infants (twins & triplets)
 - » Children recovering from cancer treatment
- Children's applicants must meet HOME Choice eligibility requirements

Residential Treatment Facilities

- HOME Choice includes Residential Treatment Facilities among Qualified Institutions
 - » An Institution licensed by the Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services or certified by the Department of Job and Family Services
 - » That serves children (21 and under)
 - » And either has more than sixteen beds or is part of a campus of multiple facilities or institutions that, combined, have a total of more than sixteen beds
- RTF applicants must meet other HOME Choice eligibility requirements

Nuances of the Child/Youth Population

- Custody/Guardian changes can occur throughout participation
- Goods & Services-
 - » balancing the use and understanding the funds are for the participant, the child. May mean saying no to families.
 - » The team may have to think outside the box and use goods & services for unusual purposes (with approval from CLA)
- Supplemental Services-ILST or CSC may be working with the parent(s) or guardian
- Discharge timing
 - » Children's Hospitals sometimes discharge quickly, making advance planning difficult
 - » RTF's have better planned discharges, but sometimes circumstances change quickly

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
