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**Please read this important information about your health care coverage**

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Dear Sir or Madam:

You may be eligible for the Specialized Recovery Services (SRS) program. If you are eligible, you will keep your Medicaid health care coverage and receive a new service called recovery management. This service will help make sure that you are receiving services that are specific to your needs.

The Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) hired «CMA\_Assigned» to answer any questions you may have about this program and to see if you are eligible. «CMA\_Assigned» will be calling you about this. You may also call them yourself at «CMA\_Phone\_».

You may be eligible for the SRS program if:

- You have income below \$2,205 per month (\$26,460 per year);
- You are 21 years of age or older;
- You are actively on the solid or soft transplant waiting list or have a diagnosed chronic condition, which includes *certain malignancies, HIV/AIDS or immune deficiencies, end stage renal disease (ESRD), sickle cell anemia, cystic fibrosis, hemophilia or if you have had a previous organ transplant;*
- You need help with medical appointments and/or activities of daily living;
- You receive SSI or SSDI benefits authorized by the Social Security Administration;
- You do not live in a nursing facility, hospital or similar setting.
