ADDITIONAL MITS RESOURCE DOCUMENTS NOW AVAILABLE

The departments have continued to update the **MACSIS and MITS Claims Processing in State Fiscal Year 2013** website (<http://mentalhealth.ohio.gov/what-we-do/protect-and-monitor/macsis/macsis-mits-claims-processing.shtml>) as information comes available and documents are created to support the transition to MITS for dates of service July 1, 2012 and beyond. In addition to all of the MITS Bits, you can also find information related to EDI, including companion guides and comparison between MACSIS and MITS, trading partner resources, Third Party Liability training and resources and eligibility verification services. Updates for Agencies Pursuing Trading Partner Status

In response to the needs of behavioral health providers testing to become a Medicaid trading partner, ODJFS has **tripled the number of daily testing cycles for electronic data files.**

Beginning today, ODJFS will run test files **three times each business day at 10 am, 2 pm and 6 pm.** Trading Partners will receive a response after submitting each file and will then have time to review the file and resend it or a different file for the next cycle. With this change in place, **trading partners will have the opportunity to send in files three times each business day.** In this way each submission will count towards Trading Partner certification as long as each file is submitted at a different time. Please **note** that ODJFS will send only one 835 at the end of the day for all files submitted throughout that day.

This improvement should greatly help Trading Partner applicants to reach the certification threshold of three files of at least 50 claims with a 90 percent payment rate.
