

## **ICF-IID Providers to Direct Bill – 7/01/15 DOS**

### **When is this change effective?**

Beginning with July 1, 2015 dates of service, the MITS system will no longer automatically generate ICF-IID per diem claims. Instead, providers are now required to submit claims via the MITS provider portal or electronic data interchange (EDI). EDI claims can only be submitted by an authorized trading partner (see the Providers: Trading Partner page on Ohio's Medicaid website).

### **How to request payment/payment adjustments for prior periods?**

For dates of service prior to July 1, 2015, continue to FAX the ODM 09400 Form to the LTC Payment Unit at 614-995-5959.
