

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
2015 P4P

- Method: Higher Performance = Higher Pay
 - » Evaluation Period: CY 2014
 - » Measures: 6 measures aligned with Medicaid's Quality Strategy
 - » Data Source: MCP self-reported audited HEDIS
- Amount: 1.25% of premium
- Standards:
 - » Based on HEDIS 2013 national Medicaid percentiles
 - » Payout starts above 25th percentile
 - » 1.25% awarded if at or above 75th percentile
- **New for 2015 – Quality Improvement**
 - » MCP required to implement one Quality Improvement Project (QIP) for each P4P measure that does not meet specified standards













Follow-up after MH Hospitalization (7day) 2015 P4P



Timeliness of Prenatal Care 2015 P4P





Use of Appropriate Medications for People with Asthma 2015 P4P





Diabetes: HbA1c Control (<8.0%) 2015 P4P



Percent Awarded for All Measures




- P4P Quality Improvement

- » Purpose: to monitor MCP quality improvement
- » MCP is required to develop and implement one Quality Improvement Project (QIP) for each P4P measure result that does not meet or exceed the standard listed below
- » Standards: estimated 5th %ile, based on HEDIS 2013 National Medicaid percentiles
 - Follow-up After Hospitalization for Mental Illness ≥ 21.3%
 - Timeliness of Prenatal Care ≥ 69.2%
 - Controlling High Blood Pressure ≥ 39.6%
 - Use of Appropriate Medications for People with Asthma ≥ 78.8%
 - Appropriate Treatment for Children with URI ≥ 76.3%
 - Diabetes: HbA1c Control (<8.0%) ≥ 32.6%

Next Year - 2016 P4P

- MCP incentive payment = **1.5%** of premium
 - » Clinical performance measures – **7 measures** for 2016
 - MCP's potential payout amount (**1.25%** of premium) is divided equally among the seven measures
 - Standards:
 - Payout starts above 25th percentile – 1.25% awarded if at or above 75th percentile
 - » Care Management Performance measure – **new for 2016**
 - Operational readiness for care managing 2% at the High Risk stratification level: Standard=TBD
 - **.25%** of premium awarded if MCP meets the standard
- Quality Improvement
 - » To include the 7 clinical performance P4P measures – Quality Improvement standards are TBD
