Opening Minds through Art (OMA) Quarterly Progress Report to the Ohio Department of Medicaid

Timeframe: October 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016

The Scripps OMA program has had a busy and productive second quarter. During this time period, we accomplished the following:

Recruitment efforts:

- 1. Sent out RFP announcements about OMA-QIP training and funding opportunity multiple times to all 960 nursing throughout Ohio using Scripps Gerontology Center's network and social media.
- 2. Presented OMA-QIP training and funding opportunity to Scripps Long-term Care Advisory board on 10/6/16 in Columbus, OH. About a dozen leaders in long-term care industry were present and brought the information back to their organizations.
- 3. Conducted a free webinar on OMA-QIP training and funding opportunity and how to complete the application form on 10/25/16. This webinar was attended by 111 individuals. The webinar was then posted on Scripps Gerontology Center's website for those who could not attend the actual session or for reviewing purposes.
- 4. Presented OMA-QIP training and funding opportunity at LeadingAge Conference and Expo in Indianapolis, IN on 11/2/16.
- 5. Presented OMA-QIP training and funding opportunity and how to complete the application form to Ohio Living facilities at Ohio Living Mount Pleasant on 11/8/16. Twelve people from five different Ohio Living facilities attended the session.

Selection Process:

- 1. Reviewed applications from 50 Ohio nursing homes and selected 14 to receive training and funding in the first cohort.
- 2. Opened online registration for these 14 nursing homes to commit to their participation in the project on 12/16/16. The deadline for registration is 1/13/16. They will be trained in May and June of 2016.
- 3. Identified 13 additional nursing homes that qualified for OMA-QIP training and funding in the second cohort. They will be trained in August 2017.

Materials Development:

- 1. Worked with Michael DeGrazier, videographer, to complete shooting videos for online training material development on 10/15/16.
- 2. Announced RFP for IT companies to develop OMA online training course on 9/30/16; Reviewed 7 applicants on 11/11/16; Conducted meetings with 3 finalists and hired one IT company on 12/20/16; Selected one company, Earthling Interactive (http://earthlinginteractive.com) on 12/22/16 to work with OMA in the next 2.5 years.
