Pregnancy Related Services

In addition to regular prenatal care, these preventive health care and support services can help to increase your well-being during pregnancy and increase the likelihood of having a healthy baby.



What services are available?

- » help making your medical appointments
- » transportation to Medicaid-covered services
- » referral to Women, Infants and Children (WIC). This is a program that gives food and nutrition education to eligible pregnant women, mothers, and children.
- » other referrals based on your needs
- » information about Healthchek services for your child (or for you if you are younger than age 21)



How do I get pregnancy related services?

- » Call your local county department of job and family services office. Ask for the Pregnancy Related Services Coordinator.
