The most recent Request for Applications combined both CFC and ABD populations.</p> <p>A list of Specialty Providers was provided and posted to the committee’s website.</p> <p>The Health Home program will be utilized.</p> <p>OHP will send the MCPs historical claim data prior to enrollment in order to quickly develop plans of care.</p> <p>Behavioral health benefit is carved out.</p> <p>Children with cystic fibrosis, hemophilia, or children receiving cancer treatments will not be enrolled in a MCP</p>	<p>Question of data availability was raised.</p>
Patrick Beatty- ACA	<p>Discuss of Supreme Court decision was discussed. Most provisions were left intact, including expansion of Medicaid.</p> <p>OHP project underway to expand access will continue.</p>	<p>Questions of Medicaid expansion were raised.</p> <p>Members were reminded that comment for the Eligibility Modernization proposal are July 6th.</p>
Ben Johnson – Facebook	<p>Any interest had been expressed in maintaining a Facebook page as a communication for families with children into managed care. In addition to Facebook, ODJFS also utilizes YouTube and Twitter for communication purposes.</p>	
General Update – Patrick	<p>2 pregnant women were presumptive enrolled, as was one baby.</p> <p>Statewide rollout to hospital and FQHCs is October 2012 through January 2013.</p>
