

## HCBS STATEWIDE TRANSITION PLAN: DEFINITIONS AND ACROYNMS

TERM	DEFINITION
<b>ASSISTED LIVING</b>	Housing for elderly or disabled adults that provides a range of services included hands-on assistance with personal care, housekeeping, and meals.
<b>CMS</b>	Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services: The agency is part of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services that oversees many federal healthcare programs.
<b>DODD</b>	Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities. The State agency that oversees a statewide system of supportive services for people of all ages with intellectual and developmental disabilities.
<b>HCBS</b>	Home and Community Based Services. Services that allow a person to receive services and supports in their own home or community instead of in an institution.
<b>HCB Setting</b>	Home and community-based setting. Places where people can live, work and receive waiver services, and engage in community life.
<b>HEIGHTENED SCRUTINY</b>	The process used by CMS to determine if a specific setting has the characteristics of home and community and is not an institution.
<b>ICF</b>	Intermediate Care Facility.
<b>ICF-IID DELIVERY SYSTEM</b>	The statewide system of services and supports available to individuals who are eligible to receive services in an intermediate care facility.
<b>INSTITUTIONAL PRESUMPTION</b>	The idea that a setting does not have home and community qualities because of where it's located.
<b>NF</b>	Nursing Facility
<b>NF-LOC DELIVERY SYSTEM</b>	The statewide system of services and supports available to individual who are eligible to services in a nursing facility.

<b>ODA</b>	Ohio Department of Aging. The State agency that oversees a statewide system of services for older adults.
<b>ODH</b>	Ohio Department of Health. The State agency whose responsibilities include oversight of nursing facilities and residential care facilities such as assisted living facilities.
<b>ODM</b>	Ohio Department of Medicaid. The State agency that oversees the delivery of health care services and long-term services and supports.
<b>PAA</b>	PASSPORT Administrative Agency.
<b>PRONG 1</b>	Settings in facilities, such as nursing facilities or intermediate care facilities, providing inpatient institutional services.
<b>PRONG 2</b>	Settings on the grounds of or adjacent to public institutions.
<b>PRONG 3</b>	Settings that have the effect of isolating individuals receiving HCBS services from the broader community.
<b>RCF</b>	Residential Care Facility. A setting licensed by the Department of Health and generally referred to as assisted living.
<b>REMEDICATION PLAN</b>	The action steps required to ensure the setting is compliant with the regulation.
<b>SCR</b>	Structural Compliance Review. The process used by the Ohio Department of Aging to ensure HCBS settings are compliant with the regulation.
<b>STP</b>	Statewide Transition Plan: Description of how the state will ensure all settings where individuals live and/or receive HCBS services are compliant with the regulation.
