*Prong 3: Settings that have the effect of isolating individuals receiving Medicaid HCBS from the broader community of individuals not receiving Medicaid HCBS.

The state initially determined these four settings fell under the institutional presumption due to having the effect of isolating individuals. The state requested the settings implement remediation to comply with regulatory criteria.

The state attested that the settings have remediated isolating characteristics, as demonstrated by the submission of Heightened Scrutiny Evidence Packages submitted to CMS on 10/16/2017. As a result, the state requested the settings be retraced from the heightened scrutiny review process.
