SUBJECT: Provider Revalidation Waiver

Summary

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) requested increased flexibility from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). ODM was granted approval for multiple flexibilities from federal requirements in accordance with section 1135 of the Social Security Act.

One of these flexibilities, was a waiver of provider agreement revalidation requirements for the duration of the public health emergency (PHE). While the PHE is in effect nationwide, providers who are enrolled by ODM and have a revalidation date during this period will not be required to complete the revalidation process. Provider agreements of those impacted will be extended and revalidations will resume once the PHE has been lifted by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. For providers who may be impacted, there is no required action at this time.
