Urgent Notice: Completing the Transition from 4010 to 5010

Attention Medicaid Providers and Partners:

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid's (CMS) compliance date for implementation of HIPAA Version 5010 for all EDI transactions was January 1, 2012.

Have you and/or your vendors completed the transition to HIPAA Version 5010?

ODJFS is actively communicating with all Medicaid Trading Partners to encourage them to complete the necessary steps to convert their electronic systems.

If you submit EDI transactions or work with a software vendor, billing company, clearinghouse, or other entity engaged in Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) transactions, please make sure the transition to HIPAA Version 5010 is complete.

If you or your vendors have not completed the transition yet, please prepare to complete the transition no later than March 31, 2012.

After March 31, 2012 transactions sent to ODJFS in 4010 format will be rejected.

Your immediate action is needed to ensure that your claims are paid accurately and timely. We strongly encourage you to verify that your systems and your vendors' systems are fully functional using HIPAA Version 5010.
