What are these Baseline Values used for?

- Baseline values are used to determine:
 - » Which practices will be eligible to receive 65% shared savings, for practices who qualify
- Based on the year two years prior to the performance year on which the shared savings will be based
 - » E.g., 2016 baseline values are used to determine the bottom 10th percentile for 2018 performance year shared savings
