CPC Enrollment for 2021

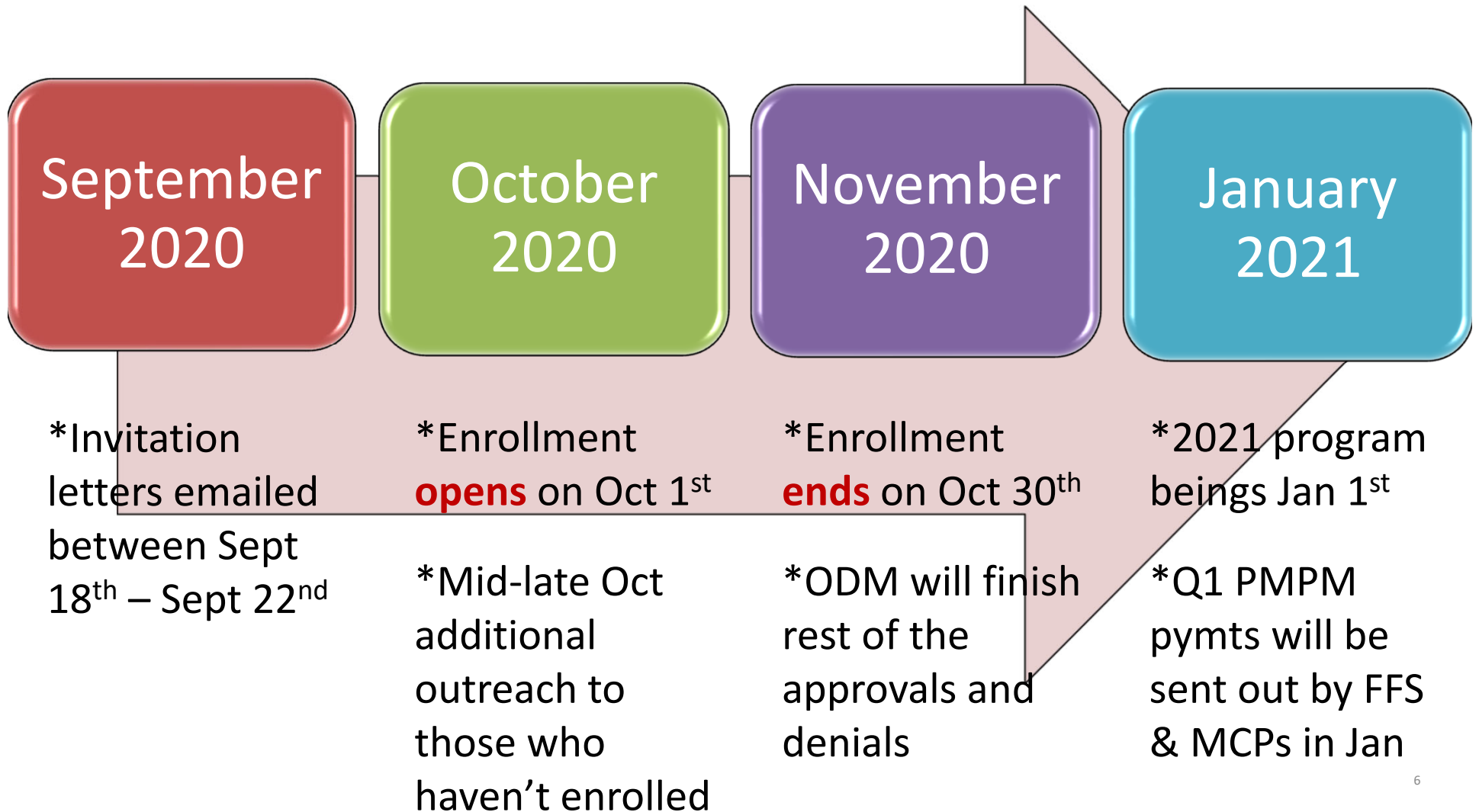
CPC 2020 Recap

- Almost **300** practices, including 30 practice partnerships, received over **\$70M** in PMPM payments
- Over **1.4M** Medicaid lives touched by CPC, including over **three quarters of a million** kids
- Qsource completed over 100 desk and in-person activity requirement reviews from 2019, resulting in 17 successfully completed performance improvement plans!
 - » **Great job to all 2019 practices in meeting activity requirements!**

CPC Enrollment Reminders

- Invitations were sent to the service location email address found in MITS
 - » Under the 7-digit CPC Medicaid ID if you have an active one
 - » Under the 7-digit Medicaid ID if there is no active CPC ID
- Providers can participate one of two ways:
 - » Individual entity
 - » Practice Partnership entity
- Medicaid ID vs CPC ID
 - » The CPC ID is only needed for re-attesting in the MITS portal
 - Someone must have created a MITS admin account with the CPC ID and pin received in their welcome letter the original year of new enrollment

2021 CPC Enrollment Timeline



Who Gets the Invite to Enroll/Re-attest?

Vendor runs attribution logic to look for which providers meet our criteria for enrollment

1. ODM uses an “anchor” date which has been 6/1/XX
 - Essentially this is an end date to start the look back period on previous claims
2. Vendor then uses the look back period of 17 months 1/1/XX – 5/31/XX
 - This is for all FFS claims and encounters received by a specific date
 - The 7-digit Medicaid ID is used, **NOT** NPI or tax ID
 - The paid date must be before the cut-off and the DOS must be within the look back period

2021 enrollment: The lookback was 1/1/19-6/01/20 for all received by 07/14/20

3. Vendor runs our attribution method and attributes all eligible individuals
4. ODM breaks the data down so we know who falls where with eligibility:
 - A practice that gets over 500+ members attributed to them can enroll individually
 - A practice that gets 150-499+ members attributed to must enroll with a partnership (to equal a total of 500 min)
 - A practice 149 and under has NO eligibility

Who Should Complete a New Enrollment

- In CPC today within a partnership but want/need to convene a new partnership
- In CPC today individually but want/need to convene a new partnership
- In CPC today as a partnership but want/need to become an individual entity for the first time
- Never been in CPC before and want to join

Who Should Complete a Re-Attestation

- In CPC today as the convener to a practice partnership and the convening practice is continuing
 - *Even if some of the other practices are joining or leaving
- In CPC today individually and continuing that way
- In CPC today within a partnership but the partnership is dissolving/not continuing for whatever reason:
 - *Prior to the partnership, participation in CPC was individual and a CPC ID had been created with that original enrollment

CPC Requirements	The enrollment period for the 2021 program year will be October 1, 2020 to October 30, 2020. All currently enrolled practices eligible for next year will receive an invitation to re-attest. All new practices that are eligible to participate will receive an invitation to enroll. All invitations to join CPC for the 2021 program year will be emailed out by the end of September 2020.

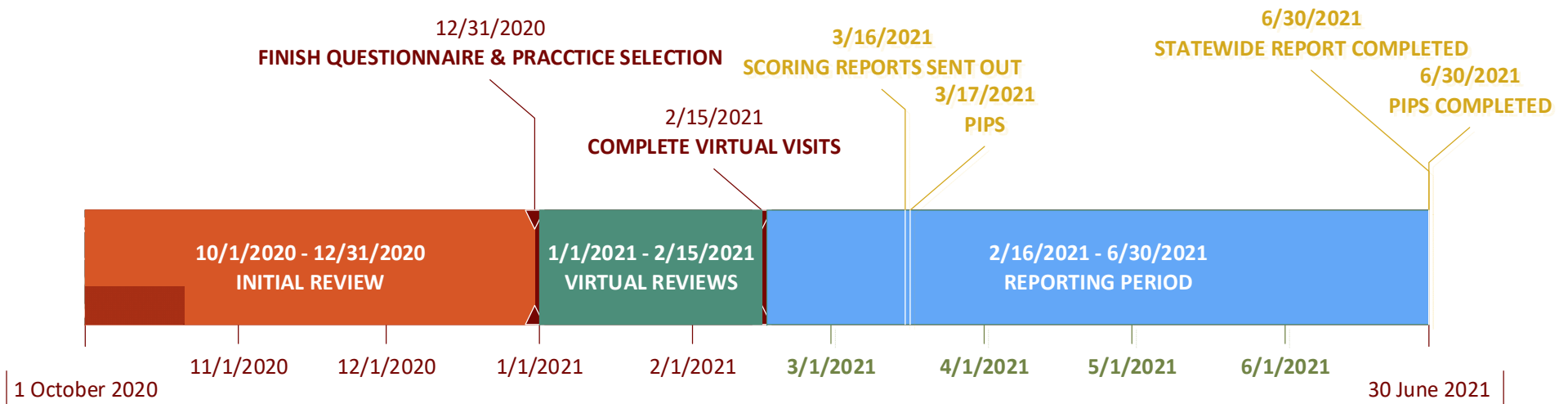
- 2019 Reviews

 - Process will consist of:
 - Questionnaire
 - »All Practices
 - »Electronic
 - Virtual Review for selected practices
 - Review Scoring Reports will be sent out
 - Performance Improvement Plans for lower performing practices
