Subject: Omnipod Coverage Under the Medicaid Pharmacy Benefit

The Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) will be adding coverage of Omnipod products under the Ohio Medicaid Fee-for-Service (FFS) pharmacy benefit. As a result, ODM is requiring managed care plans (MCPs) to offer coverage for Omnipod. Omnipod is a two-part tubeless insulin system for the management of diabetes. It has a handheld Personal Diabetes Manager (PDM) device that controls the delivery of insulin via 3-day disposable Pods. In FFS, the Omnipod will require clinical prior authorization. The national drug codes (NDCs) for these products are listed below.

ODM coverage will be effective in FFS 1/1/19. MCPs must cover the Omnipod under the pharmacy benefit no later than 2/1/19.
