Subject: Specialized Recovery Services Program and Managed Care Enrollment Update

During the development and initial implementation of the Specialized Recovery Services Program¹ (SRSP), it was decided to hold SRS-eligible individuals out of Medicaid Managed Care (MMC) and MyCare Ohio for a period of time, except individuals already enrolled in a plan who became eligible for SRSP remained in their MMC or MyCare Ohio plan.

While some individuals are currently enrolled in a plan, many are still on Fee-for-Service (FFS) Medicaid. SRSP services provided to an individual in MMC are carved-out and paid for by the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM), while SRSP services provided to individuals in MyCare Ohio are carved-in and providers are paid by the respective plan.

Beginning July 1, 2018, all new SRSP recipients who are eligible for MMC or MyCare Ohio will be enrolled in a plan. Current SRSP recipients covered under FFS Medicaid, will be enrolled in a plan using a phased in approach beginning January 1, 2019. This plan is being developed and will be shared once it is finalized.

MAGI/ABD Medicaid eligible individuals (non-dual) – Individuals will enroll in one of the five following MMC plans for their Medicaid State Plan services.

- Buckeye
- CareSource
- Molina
- Paramount
- United Healthcare

SRSP services will continue to be carved out to FFS Medicaid. SRSP service providers will continue to bill FFS Medicaid as they currently do. MMC plans will be required to coordinate care for these individuals with the recovery management agencies, including assistance locating a provider, arranging transportation, addressing barriers to care, etc.

Dual Eligible Individuals – Individuals who live in one of the 29 MyCare Ohio Counties, will enroll in one of the five following MyCare Ohio plans, based on their county of residence, for their Medicaid State Plan services and SRS services, which are carved-in.

- Aetna
- Buckeye
- CareSource
- Molina
- United Healthcare

MyCare Ohio plans will also be required to coordinate care for these individuals with the recovery management entities.
