



First Quarter Grant Report: *Creating a Culture of Person-Directed Dementia Care* SFY 2019 – 2020 Person-Directed Dementia Care Project

The following grant activities were completed during the first quarter of the grant period: Quarter 1 July 1 – September 30, 2018

- Our contract began on August 1, 2018.
- The Eden Alternative worked with the educators for all events to find dates that worked for them for in-person and online events.
