

Progress Report #2
July 1 to September 30, 2017
CMP Grant: ItcGAIN Program -- Focused Nurse Education

The following outlines the progress made on the above-named grant between July 1 and September 30, 2017:

1. The website at <http://lfcgain.org> is continuing to be refined and populated with new content.
2. The first four modules are coming together well – COPD, Pneumonia, Heart Failure and Diabetes. Development of the Stroke module is well underway.
3. Peer review has been ongoing within the development team throughout curriculum development.
4. Curriculum planning and development is underway for UTI and Pressure Wounds.
5. The draft video scenarios and SBAR communications graphics have been developed for each of the 7 modules. These will be revised to mesh with the final module curriculum content after all revisions are made and prior to recording of the videos.
6. The pre/post tests for Heart Failure, COPD, Diabetes, and Pneumonia have been created, with Stroke to follow very soon.
7. The COPD, Diabetes and Pneumonia modules are being reviewed by the directors of nursing in four long-term care communities, who are currently providing their critiques, and revisions will be made prior to release of the program. The Stroke module will be shared with the module reviewers in the next week or so.
8. The on-line individual module evaluations and module certificates have been developed and have been incorporated into the website.
9. The on-line registration questions have been developed and will be incorporated into the website very soon.
10. Applications for nursing continuing education are being completed by LeadingAge Ohio as each module is developed.
11. Grant funds have been received from the Ohio Department of Medicaid for the FY 18 timeframe and invoices have been received by LeadingAge Ohio from the OSU College of Nursing, the OSU Office of Geriatrics and Interprofessional Studies and the Optimized Care Network for work completed during July, August and September in the amount of \$18,770.00.
