SUBJECT: Inpatient Hospital Rule Rescissions

Summary

This Hospital Handbook Transmittal Letter (HHTL) provides information pertaining to inpatient hospital reimbursement rules. Effective July 1, 2013, Ohio Administrative Code rules 5160-2-07.1, 5160-2-07.4, 5160-2-07.8 and 5160-2-07.11 were replaced by 5160-2-65 and are now rescinded. Effective July 1, 2017 Ohio Administrative Code rule 5160-2-07.2 was replaced by 5160-2-05 and is now rescinded.

Rule Changes

Rule 5160-2-07.1 entitled Hospital services subject to and excluded from DRG prospective payment set forth the policies for hospital services subject to and excluded from the DRG prospective payment program. Effective 7/1/13, this rule has been replaced by rule 5160-2-65, thus this rule has been rescinded.

Rule 5160-2-07.2 entitled Classification of hospitals set forth the policy for the classification of hospitals. Effective 7/1/17 this rule has been replaced by rule 5160-2-05, thus this rule has been rescinded.

Rule 5160-2-07.4 entitled Basic methodology for determining prospective payment rates set forth the methodology for determining prospective payment rates. Effective 7/1/13, this rule has been replaced by rule 5160-2-65, thus this rule has been rescinded.

Rule 5160-2-07.8 entitled Redetermination of prospective payment rates set forth the methodology for the redetermination of prospective payment rates. Effective 7/1/13, this rule has been replaced by rule 5160-2-65, thus this rule has been rescinded.

Rule 5160-2-07.11 entitled Payment methodology, set forth the policies for inpatient claim submissions and payments. Effective 7/1/13, this rule has been replaced by rule 5160-2-65, thus this rule has been rescinded.
