SUBJECT: Replacement of Ohio Administrative Code Rule 5160-4-20

Rule 5160-04-20, "Chemotherapy treatment," which sets forth coverage and payment policies for chemotherapy services has been rescinded and replaced by a new rule of the same number. The content of new rule 5160-04-20, "Chemotherapy," has been reorganized, streamlined, and clarified.

When chemotherapy is administered in a non-hospital setting by a practitioner (such as an oncologist) or by a qualified employee supervised by a practitioner, separate payment may be made for the chemotherapeutic agent, for the administration of the agent, and (if applicable) for an evaluation and management service provided in conjunction with the chemotherapy administration.

The effective date of this rule change is January 1, 2020.
