SUBJECT: Revision of the Podiatry Services Rule OAC 5160-7-03

The purpose of this Medicaid Transmittal Letter is to provide notice of the revision of Medicaid rule Ohio 5160-7-03. The effective date of this rule revision is November 1, 2017.

Rule 5160-7-03, "Covered podiatric services and associated limitations," defines specific podiatric medicine services that are eligible for reimbursement by the Ohio Medicaid program. This rule has been amended to comply with mandatory five-year rule review. Changes were made to remove the program limit of one long-term care facility (LTCF) visit per month by a podiatrist and to provide payment for additional evaluation and management services when provided by a podiatrist. These added services are procedure codes which require medical decision making of moderate and high complexity are: 99205, 99215, 99223, 99233, 99244, 99245, 99254, 99255, 99345 and 99350.
