## Waiver Services

Some Medicaid waivers allow people with disabilities and chronic conditions to receive care in their homes and communities rather than in long-term care facilities, hospitals or intermediate care facilities. These waivers also allow people to have more control over their care and remain active in their community.

The following waivers offer services to prevent or delay institutionalization and promote independence. Examples of these services include, but are not limited to, nursing, personal care, home delivered meals and home modifications.

- Ohio Home Care Waiver for individuals age 59 or younger
- PASSPORT Waiver for individuals age 60 and older
- Assisted Living Waiver for individuals age 21 or older
- MyCare Waiver for individuals age 18 or older who receive both Medicaid and Medicare

The MyCare Waiver is limited to individuals that reside in the following counties:
