Subject: Restrictions on Payment for Services

This MEMTL contains one rule which has been amended as part of a five-year rule review in Chapter 5160:1-1 of the Administrative Code, adopted under section 111.15 of the Revised Code.

The effective date is July 1, 2021.

Chapter 1

5160:1-1-03 Medicaid: restrictions on payment for services.

This rule was amended to clarify that services provided to individuals in an institution for mental diseases (IMD) as permitted under the approved Section 1115 Substance Use Disorder Demonstration Waiver are eligible for Medicaid payments.

This rule was also updated to add language regarding the Substance Use-Disorder Prevention that Promotes Opioid Recovery and Treatment (SUPPORT) for Patients and Communities Act to not terminate coverage of inmates of a public institution who are under the age of twenty-one or former foster care individuals up to the age of twenty-six. Additionally, upon release from the public institution, a redetermination of eligibility will be processed without the need for a new application for these individuals.

Duplicative definitions that are included in other Medicaid rules have been removed and federal code citations have been updated.
