Subject: Definitions

This MEMTL contains one rule which has been amended in Chapter 5160:1-1 of the Administrative Code, adopted under section 111.15 of the Revised Code.

The effective date is April 1, 2022.

Chapter 1

5160:1-1-01 Medicaid: definitions.

This rule has been amended to add the definitions “Advance notice of adverse action,” “Applicant,” “Approve,” “Discontinue,” “Encumbrance,” “Equity value,” “Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996,” “Lawfully residing,” “Managed care organization,” “Non-Citizen Emergency Medical Assistance,” “Recipient,” and “Redetermination.” The definitions of “Alien Emergency Medical Assistance,” “Initial processing,” and “Ohio works first (OWF) sanction” have been removed. Administrative and federal code citations have been updated. Additional updates to terms and language throughout the rule were made for clarity.
