Dear Trading Partners,

The Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) continues to make strides toward HIPAA compliance of all EDI transactions. To that end we will be implementing the following changes in the Production region on Sunday February 2, 2020 during the normal scheduled maintenance.

Transaction(s)	Description
837 Dental 837 Institutional 837 Professional	The REF - Line Item Control Number in the 2400 loop must be unique within each CLM 01. This is the REF segment with the '6R' qualifier. (REF*6R*controlnumber~)
837 Dental 837 Institutional 837 Professional	The format of the 2430 Loop SVD 05 is limited to a maximum of 8 digits excluding the decimal with a maximum of 3 digits to the right of the decimal.
837 Dental 837 Professional	When using the 2320 Loop to identify Medicare as the <u>Primary</u> payer (SBR01 = P), the SBR05 must not be used. This applies to traditional Medicare (SBR 09 = MA, MB) as well as Medicare Advantage Plans (SBR 09 = 16)

These updates have been deployed to the ODM Certification / testing region. All trading partners have access to this region. ODM encourages trading partners to take advantage of this testing opportunity to confirm that their EDI transactions will not be impacted by the above improvements.

ODM will also be implementing the following change in a future release. The date is yet to be determined but is expected to be in the next couple of months. This update is not yet in the Certification / testing area, but we wanted to make you aware in advance.

837 Dental 837 Institutional 837 Professional	When the CLM 05-3 value in the 2300 Loop = 7 for a Replacement or 8 for a Void the REF segment (Payer Claim Control Number) with the 'F8' qualifier must be included. (REF*F8*payerclaimcontrol#)
